"SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, 8 the amount of \$2,557,080 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to the State Forestry Department for debt service relating to the purchase of land in the Gilchrist State Forest.

"SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from federal funds other than those described in section 2 of this 2023 Act, collected or received by the State Forestry Department, for the following purposes:

(1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appro-25 priation, there is appropriated to the Emergency Board, for the 26 biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount 27 of \$14,000,000, to be allocated to the State Forestry Department for fire 28 protection expenses. 29

"(2) If any of the moneys appropriated by subsection (1) of this

section are not allocated by the Emergency Board prior to December 1, 2024, the moneys remaining on that date become available for any purpose for which the Emergency Board lawfully may allocate funds.

"SECTION 6. This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect July 1, 2023."
