**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 5018**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 26 and delete page  
2 2 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Department of Envi-**  
4 **ronmental Quality, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the**  
5 **General Fund, the following amounts, for the following purposes:**

- 6 (1) Air quality..... \$ 23,729,099  
7 (2) Water quality..... \$ 41,029,519  
8 (3) Land quality..... \$ 2,645,890  
9 (4) Agency management..... \$ 1,754,702  
10 (5) Debt service..... \$ 8,529,380

11 **“SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**  
12 **the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July**  
13 **1, 2023, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees,**  
14 **moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, the pro-**  
15 **ceeds of bonds for the Orphan Site Account and federal funds from**  
16 **congestion mitigation and air quality grants, drinking water pro-**  
17 **tection, laboratory accreditation and woodstove grants and for smoke**  
18 **monitoring laboratory services, but excluding lottery funds and federal**  
19 **funds not described in this section, collected or received by the De-**  
20 **partment of Environmental Quality, for the following purposes:**

- 21 (1) Air quality..... \$113,325,766

- 1       (2) Water quality..... \$ 32,957,021
- 2       (3) Land quality..... \$ 99,073,155
- 3       (4) Agency management..... \$ 43,964,101

4       **“SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**  
 5 **the amount of \$6,453,619 is established for the biennium beginning July**  
 6 **1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery**  
 7 **moneys allocated from the Parks and Natural Resources Fund to the**  
 8 **Department of Environmental Quality for activities and projects to**  
 9 **implement Article XV, section 4 (8), of the Oregon Constitution.**

10       **“SECTION 4. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, the following**  
 11 **expenditures by the Department of Environmental Quality are not**  
 12 **limited:**

13       **“(1) Expenditures for debt service and debt service administrative**  
 14 **costs related to the Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund and the**  
 15 **Pollution Control Fund; and**

16       **“(2) Expenditures made for loans from the Water Pollution Control**  
 17 **Revolving Fund and loans from the Pollution Control Fund.**

18       **“SECTION 5. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**  
 19 **the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July**  
 20 **1, 2023, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from federal**  
 21 **funds other than those described in section 2 of this 2023 Act, collected**  
 22 **or received by the Department of Environmental Quality, for the fol-**  
 23 **lowing purposes:**

- 24       (1) Air quality..... \$ 13,517,595
- 25       (2) Water quality..... \$ 18,729,195
- 26       (3) Land quality..... \$ 8,857,121

27       **“SECTION 6. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**  
 28 **the amount of \$10,805,524 is established for the biennium beginning**  
 29 **July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the**  
 30 **Department of Environmental Quality from American Rescue Plan Act**

1 **Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund moneys received by the**  
2 **Oregon Department of Administrative Services and transferred to the**  
3 **Department of Environmental Quality, for the Onsite Septic Financial**  
4 **Aid Program.**

5 **“SECTION 7. This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate**  
6 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**  
7 **declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect July 1, 2023.”.**

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
