Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, 5 the limitation on expenditures established by section 6 (4), chapter 603, 6 Oregon Laws 2021, for the biennium ending June 30, 2023, as the max-7 imum limit for payment of grants-in-aid, program costs and purchased 8 services from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous 9 Receipts, but excluding lottery funds, corporate activity tax funds and 10 federal funds, collected or received by the Department of Education 11 for programs other than those specified in sections 5 and 14, chapter 12 603, Oregon Laws 2021, for all other grants, is increased by \$1,341,219, 13 for expenditures from the School Stabilization Subaccount for 14 Wildfire-impacted School Districts. 15

"SECTION 17. This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect July 1, 2023."

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
