**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 1**

1 On page 3 of the printed A-engrossed bill, after line 12, insert:

2 **“SECTION 9. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the**  
3 **General Fund appropriation made to the Department of Revenue by**  
4 **section 1 (3), chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2023 (Enrolled House Bill 5034),**  
5 **for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, for the Personal Tax and**  
6 **Compliance Division, is increased by \$259,658, for developing a schedule**  
7 **allowing personal income taxpayers to voluntarily report self-identified**  
8 **race and ethnicity identifiers.**

9 **“(2) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund**  
10 **appropriation made to the Department of Revenue by section 1 (6),**  
11 **chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2023 (Enrolled House Bill 5034), for the**  
12 **biennium beginning July 1, 2023, for the Information Technology Ser-**  
13 **vices Division, is increased by \$164,842, for developing and maintaining**  
14 **data collection of self-identified race and ethnicity identifiers.**

15 **“(3) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund**  
16 **appropriation made to the Department of Revenue by section 1 (1),**  
17 **chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2023 (Enrolled House Bill 5034), for the**  
18 **biennium beginning July 1, 2023, for Administration, is increased by**  
19 **\$46,224, for the research and development of racial impact statements.**

20 **“SECTION 10. (1) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expendi-**  
21 **tures, the limitation on expenditures established by section 2 (3),**

1 chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2023 (Enrolled House Bill 5034), for the  
2 biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment  
3 of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscella-  
4 neous Receipts and reimbursements from federal service agreements,  
5 but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in section  
6 2, chapter \_\_, Oregon Laws 2023 (Enrolled House Bill 5034), collected  
7 or received by the Department of Revenue, for the Personal Tax and  
8 Compliance Division, is increased by \$6,357, for developing a schedule  
9 allowing personal income taxpayers to voluntarily report self-identified  
10 race and ethnicity identifiers.

11 “(2) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limi-  
12 tation on expenditures established by section 2 (7), chapter \_\_, Oregon  
13 Laws 2023 (Enrolled House Bill 5034), for the biennium beginning July  
14 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees,  
15 moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and re-  
16 imbursements from federal service agreements, but excluding lottery  
17 funds and federal funds not described in section 2, chapter \_\_, Oregon  
18 Laws 2023 (Enrolled House Bill 5034), collected or received by the De-  
19 partment of Revenue, for the Information Technology Services Divi-  
20 sion, is increased by \$11,460, for developing and maintaining data  
21 collection of self-identified race and ethnicity identifiers.

22 “(3) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limi-  
23 tation on expenditures established by section 2 (1), chapter \_\_, Oregon  
24 Laws 2023 (Enrolled House Bill 5034), for the biennium beginning July  
25 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees,  
26 moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and re-  
27 imbursements from federal service agreements, but excluding lottery  
28 funds and federal funds not described in section 2, chapter \_\_, Oregon  
29 Laws 2023 (Enrolled House Bill 5034), collected or received by the De-  
30 partment of Revenue, for Administration, is increased by \$10,392, for

1 **the research and development of racial impact statements.”.**

2 In line 13, delete “9” and insert “11”.

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
