Goal 14 by enforcing a urban growth boundaries for Oregon's cities already includes an orderly process for expansion, and it thereby plays a fundamental and important role in reducing the externalized costs of urban sprawl. There are already substantial unfunded infrastructure needs in existing urban areas. The dash -17 amendment will unnecessarily increase infrastructure costs for everyone. The dash -17 amendment breaks an important commitment that has been maintained for decades and is essential to be maintained.
