I applaud those who participated in the construction and analysis in the aforementioned "FISCAL IMPACT OF THE PROPOSED LEGISLATION."

Now that the ceremonial matters have concluded, there are several pieces of Legislation this session pertaining to the study of and availability of water.

Water availability is threatened due to residential development-which should come to a grinding halt.
