With these changes, I'll be able to safely and confidently sell herbal tea blends made entirely with ingredients grown on farm as well as steam juiced and canned grape juice online and in person . These are both completely safe value added products that our customers are wanting to access, and that we would like to continue to offer without fear of reprisal.
