RE: Support for SB 507 (Updating the Farm Direct Marketing Law)

Dear Chair Golden and Committee Members:

Thank you for the opportunity to provide testimony in support of SB 507. 1000 Friends of Oregon is a nonprofit, membership organization that has worked with Oregonians for more than 45 years to support livable urban and rural communities; protect family farms, forests and natural areas; and provide transportation and housing choices. We created our Food Systems Program in 2015 to expand our work with partner organizations throughout the state who are working together to build and strengthen robust and healthy food systems across Oregon.

Even before the creation of our Food Systems Program, we were among the large number of organizations that advocated for passage of the original Farm Direct marketing Law, HB 2336, in 2011. That law allows farmers to bring certain low risk, value-added products to farmer markets and their farm stands. The result has been a strengthening of local and regional food systems, as countless farmers and communities, particularly in rural Oregon, have benefited from the increased economic capital generated by farm to consumer sales

Now, a decade later, it is time to update and modernize the law. SB 507 offers a number of enhancements that will expand opportunities and benefits that this program brings.

We urge you to support SB 507. Thank you for consideration of our comments.
