Our company, Rebel Spirit, in Eugene now employs 21 full time workers. One year ago, we employed 46. We are fighting to keep from going under. I am proud to have been in the legal cannabis industry in Oregon since 2016, but we are afraid that if this passes, we will go under. Simply, this tax would make it harder for us to be price competitive with the illicit market, create more financial instability for our business, and hurt our ability to innovate and expand.
