My name is Benjamin Williams, and I am a board member for the Oregon Coast Community Forest Association. We work to promote sustainable forestry practices to ensure the health of the forests and the community. Managing forests properly can ensure the maximum amount of healthy drinking water for the community, healthy streams for wildlife, and a healthy, diverse ecosystem where life and resources can thrive.

I am writing today in support of HB 2813, a bipartisan bill that would help ensure secure and safe drinking water for communities in Oregon. HB 2813 would help communities and water suppliers secure plentiful drinking water, increase resilience to climate change, and provide a state funding source to protect water resources and public health.

Water is essential for life. Without proper management of the lands feeding the watershed, this resource will continue to diminish until lost. The quality of the water matters also. You do not have to look far to see how immediate and dire this situation is becoming, and rapidly. This bill is a great opportunity.
