I encourage our Oregon state legislators to support SB 767. As a long time supporter of a tiny Oregon school district (Pinehurst #94), I am alarmed and dismayed that we currently find ourselves wrestling with an unsolicited proposal from a California charter school corporation seeking to establish themselves in our school district. The John Adams Academy (JAA) is waging nothing less than a hostile takeover.
