The lease on his school will soon be up and after 10 years of searching they have found a building 0.5 miles outside of the boundary. If this bill passes as it is without any exceptions then this could mean the end of this school, and the displacement of hundreds of students from their beloved school. I am pleading that there be some exceptions, such as the school can operate within 2 miles outside of their boundary. Or the school should be made up of a student population from the majority of the district. Please be aware that passing this bill without any exceptions can mean the END of some Oregon charter schools, including my own child's school.
