I have the feeling that there are many of those who work in our state capitol building who haven't gotten a chance to read the Oregon Constitution, so I have provided some key parts below.

In Article 1 Section 26 of the Oregon Constitution, it states: No law shall be passed restraining any of the inhabitants of the State from assembling tother in a peaceable manner to consult for their common good; nor from instructing their Representatives; nor from applying to the Legislature for redress of grievances.

Article 1 Section 27 states: The people shall have the rights to bear arms for the defense of themselves, and the State but the military shall be kept in strict subordination to the CIVIL POWER (militia)

With the introduction of this bill, limits would be clearly set on who is allowed to form groups, and for what reasons individuals choose to form them.
