As you are well aware, we are all facing economic headwinds, with hiring a dedicated workforce being among the greatest challenges, especially in areas such as Southern Oregon, where the pool of potential candidates is smaller than in the Portland-Metro area or the Mid-Willamette Valley. The work required is person-centered and critical to those we serve, yet the average fast-food employee can make more per hour. We are left recruiting those with a true heart for service, but we desperately need a wage that can help us retain them.
