Health Care Authority (HCA) acknowledges receipt of your information request received and date stamped in this office on September 21, 2022. The number assigned to your request is IR-22-0049. Please reference this number on all future correspondence regarding the request.

It is our interpretation that you are requesting the following information:

- How much money has Washington spent each year since 2020 to have these enrollees retain Medicaid services?
- How much Federal Match has Washington received each year that is attributable to this program?
- How much the state is saving by having people working. They will be on state services regardless but if they're working they contribute back by contributing to the tax base and reducing the amount of impact on other services like food stamps, housing, general healthcare that might be provided by their employer.
- In retrospect, do you have any ideas about what the state might have done differently in creating this bill. Would you increase the amount of hours that are required to work per month before eligibility for this program or the percentage that people pay or any other item/idea
- Is the money that you receive from the federal government because people are on this program offset the original cost that the state incurs if people aren't working
