Since implemented, my business has paid tens of thousands of dollars in CAT taxes, money not available to provide increased employee wages and benefits, and limits the number of new employees who I can hire. I can also attest how this revenuebased tax accumulates in the economy: after passing, ALL of my local vendors simply increased their prices, as did my business to our customers. Even with only 2-3 layers of this tax, retail prices increased more than 10%! What is worse there are some prices that I am capped at and cannot pass the increased cost on; therefore it has hit my profits which is making me insolvent as a business.
