The passage of House Bill 2433 would provide significant relief to our family farmers and ranchers.

Over 96 percent of our state's farms and ranches are family owned and operated. Many of these farms have high gross sales and extremely thin margins.

Passing this bill and increasing the threshold to \$5 million would be a meaningful improvement and signal support for farmers and ranchers across our state.
