The difficulty with MHFA is that it is outmoded, with its incentives to interpret normal adolescent behavior as indicators of mental illness. If a child's particular behavior is considered rightly or wrongly to be indicative of mental illness, this then leads to a diagnosis, a lifelong punitive quandary. This is certainly no way in which to boost a person's sense of self-esteem!

As an alternative, I'd like to suggest that training in the methods of Emotional CPR, (eCPR,) be promoted instead.
