## **RE: Support Senate Bill 530, Natural Climate Solutions**

In doing so, SB 530 will position the state to harness billions of dollars in recently passed federal funding and private investments in natural climate solutions, by creating a source of state funding for voluntary actions to remove climate pollution from the atmosphere and store it in natural and working lands.
