Greeting,

As a UAV business owner, FAA Part 107 certified UAV operator, and a member of the Academy of Model Aeronautics (AMA) I oppose this bill as written. I have also served Oregon for 25 years employed for a state regulatory agency.

I oppose for the following reasons:

- \* The bill gives a blanket authorization for public agencies to prohibit the take-off and landing of UAVs without just cause, and
- \* The bill does not give any options to the Oregon public or businesses to challenge an unjustified prohibition.
- \* Does not provide any options for waivers or exemptions to prohibitions (business, filming, search & rescue, police activity, educational research, survey)

If there were fact-based guidelines/limits on when and where to prohibit UAV's included with this bill, I might be more supportive. As written, this bill is unfairly targeting Oregon citizens and businesses from practicing their trade or enjoying hobby without providing any methods of recourse.
