Chair Golden, Vice-Chair Girod, and members of the Senate Natural Resources Committee:

I am writing on behalf of Oregon Climate and Agriculture Network in support of the Natural Climate Solutions Bill, SB 530. As you will see in the list attached to this testimony, over 50 farms and ranches from across the state have endorsed SB 530.

Oregon's farmers and ranchers are experiencing the impacts of climate change with drought, extreme heat, floods and wildfires. At the same time, farmers have an important role to play in mitigating climate change. Agricultural practices with the potential to sequester carbon include:

- cover cropping
- compost application
- no till and reduced tillage
- rotational grazing
- silvopasture, riparian plantings, hedgerows, and other agroforestry practices

Farmers who want to make changes in their practices to mitigate and be more resilient to climate change need support. SB 530 provides funding and direction to the state to provide financial incentives and a robust, knowledgeable technical assistance system to support farmers and ranchers. Technical assistance, including farmer to farmer support, could be provided by trusted farm service providers like OSU Extension and Soil and Water Conservation Districts. Financial assistance could be provided with grants from Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board (OWEB) for practices that have a carbon sequestration or climate mitigation benefit.

SB 530 would provide needed resources for farmers and ranchers who are ready to be part of the solution to the problem of a changing climate.

Please do all you can to advance SB 530 this session. Thank you for your consideration and your service.
