RE: Support for SB 530: Relating to natural climate solutions

Chair Golden and Committee Members,

On behalf of the Coalition of Oregon Land Trusts (COLT), I thank you for the opportunity to provide comments in support of the Natural and Working Lands bill (SB 530). This bill would create a dedicated fund to incentivize the *voluntary* adoption of natural climate solutions (NCS), increasing community resilience and supporting our farmers, ranchers and forest landowners.

The Coalition of Oregon Land Trusts represents 32 organizations that work to protect clean water, working farms and ranches, and fish and wildlife habitat across our state. Our mission is to serve and strengthen the land trust community in Oregon. Together, our members have worked to conserve over 370,000 acres of land.

SB 530 would incentivize practices that enhance carbon sequestration on natural and working lands, reduce greenhouse gas emissions, and increase our resilience to climate change. Our farm and rangelands, forests, and wetlands can mitigate the impacts of climate change while supporting local communities and economies. Healthy lands absorb more carbon from the atmosphere, keep plants and wildlife thriving, reduce the risk of severe wildfires, and offer natural protection to our communities from threats like flooding and pollution.

SB 530 would provide additional funding and programmatic support for private landowners to implement practices that maximize carbon sequestration. With increased support for voluntary conservation, our natural lands can be a part of the climate solution. We encourage you to support this bill and we look forward to being partners in elevating nature's ability to mitigate climate change.
