I am a mother, grandmother, and retired scientist, living on a small farm in Linn County. I am sure that you will agree that healthy forests, waters, and agricultural lands are vital to Oregon's economy, culture, and way of life. And moreover, that we need to protect these lands from current climate extremes. One of the most important steps you can take to protect the viability of Oregon's natural resource economy is to support Natural Climate Solutions (SB 350) this session.
