RE: Support for HB 2001

Chair Dexter, Co-Vice Chair Gamba, Co-Vice Chair Helfrich, and Members of the Committee:

Thank you for the opportunity to share testimony, on behalf of Northwest Pilot Project, in strong support of HB 2001 which focuses on youth homelessness prevention, provides innovative approaches to addressing housing supply barriers, and contains critical measures to help prevent eviction-caused homelessness. We appreciate the bipartisan and bicameral work that has been done to bring this bill forward.

Northwest Pilot Project (NWPP) is a social service agency with over five decades of experience in providing housing stabilization services to older adults experiencing or at risk of homelessness in Multhomah County.

We are particularly writing to urge support of Sections 14-26 of HB 2001, which contain essential and reasonable negotiated improvements to Oregon's eviction statutes to promote housing stability and minimize the threat of rapid eviction. One of the most notable sections being the reinstatement of the 10-day nonpayment notice period before being taken to court. This pandemic-era protection was critical to maintaining NWPP clients' housing stability, many of whom would have otherwise lost their housing.

With nonpayment eviction rates up approximately 43 percent from pre-pandemic numbers,¹ it is clear that we must act now to ensure Oregon's eviction process will no longer be a fast-track towards displacement and homelessness.
