1. The Oregon legislature is currently considering House Bill 2601 which would have a direct impact on PERS retirees. The legislature wants to hear from PERS retirees on this issue and Oregon PERS Retirees wants to accurately represent the views of its members.

House Bill 2601 requires the Oregon State Treasurer to divest its Oregon Public Employee Retirement Fund from fossil fuel investments, including oil and gas companies.

[Rotate Support/Oppose arguments]

Supporters of the bill say the Oregon Public Employee Retirement Fund should be leading by example and should not be funding fossil fuels or contributing to climate change with its investments.

Opponents of the bill say that HB 2601 will lead to lower investment returns for the Public Employee Retirement Fund, lower benefit levels for retirees, and a higher unfunded liability for the PERS system.
