My name is Josh Mink. I am the Athletics Director at Ontario High School. Improvements to Ontario Community Recreation Center and resources is necessary. Ontario has limited spaces for program development of youth athletics and activities. Those limits equate to extended wear and tear on existing community resources, but can also limit the number of participants due to lack of space. The recreation department, school district and other community organizations do an outstanding job of scheduling those spaces. However, in school district owned spaces, youth recreation often fills in the empty time slots that are not always convenient for families in Ontario.

The construction of a Community Resource Center will allow for expanded opportunities for the entire community. The addition of a pool in the city of Ontario will also allow Ontario High School to consider the addition of a Swim Team. This is something that has not been available to OHS students in the past. In addition to the expansion of High School sponsored opportunities, youth recreation opportunities will also be expanded.
