Thank you, Chair Holvey, members of the committee, for the opportunity to support show Lone Rock Resources' support for HB-2722.

My name is Brennan Garrelts and I live and work in rural Oregon. As a Douglas County resident, I see firsthand the challenges of engaging and employing today's youth who are less than 18-years-old. The prohibition on supervised use of power tools for 16- and 17-year-olds has created many constraints on the opportunities we can provide to our emerging-adults and the employers within our communities who provide the stable, family-wage jobs necessary to maintain vibrant and successful communities.

HB-2722 is a much needed step in the right direction to address the direct correlation between the opportunities that our local emerging-adults have for employment that involves the supervised use of power tools and the availability of a full-time labor force in entry-level, stable, family-wage jobs in rural Oregon. With the mechanization of many blue-collar jobs today, skilled training is needed to 1) prepare 16- and 17-year-olds to join the labor force and 2) educate and expose these emerging-adults to the multitude of career opportunities throughout Oregon, many of which start with on-the-ground labor working with power tools. Specific to southern Oregon, a labor shortage exists necessary to address the much-needed fuels reduction and fire mitigation work associated and funded through the 2022 SB762. This well-paying type of work is ideal for emerging-adults with supervision.

Passing of this bill will provide a much-needed pathway to give emerging-adults many of the necessary skills that employers need while providing the important supervision through vocational- or education-based organizations who can teach the appropriate safety training necessary to operate the tools safely and successfully.
