First, it would allow providers and patients confidence that their interpreters have taken necessary steps to meet state accreditation requirements. Finally, the creation of the systems outlined in this bill have been flagged as a necessary precursor to the state government directly contracting with the newly organized union for interpreters in the state. Allowing this direct negotiation will cut out the costly and unnecessary overhead of the current patchwork of private contracting companies which serves only to drive down the wages of interpreters and to drive up the cost to the state through the extraction of intermediary fees. This bill makes sense for medical providers, for patients, for workers, and for the state's budget. Please give it your support.
