


COMMUNITY RENEWABLE ENERGY GRANT PROGRAM

HB 2021 established this \$50 million program to:

- Offset costs of planning and developing community renewable energy projects
- Support projects in traditionally underserved communities
- Promote small-scale community renewable energy projects
- Provide direct benefits to communities across Oregon by improving energy resilience, creating local jobs, promoting economic development, and reducing local energy costs









- Communities of color
- Communities experiencing lower incomes
- Tribal communities
- Rural communities
- Coastal communities
- Communities with limited infrastructure
- Other communities traditionally underrepresented in public processes and adversely harmed by environmental and health hazards, including seniors, youth and persons with disabilities

PROBLEM: It's harder for some communities to apply for grants and other resources.



SOLUTION: Program at ODOE to connect knowledge and expertise on energy funding with underresourced communities





SUMMARY

Directs State Department of Energy to establish program to provide assistance related to energy projects and activities to environmental justice communities.

- 4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> The State Department of Energy shall establish a program to provide as-6 sistance related to energy projects and activities to environmental justice communities, as 7 defined in ORS 469A.400. At a minimum, the program must provide environmental justice 8 communities with information regarding:
- 9 (1) Funding resources.
- 10 (2) Technical assistance.
- 11 (3) Other support that may be available.
