Improving indoor air quality is cost effective, and it comes with an impressive list of benefits. Ventilation helps clear virus particles from the air, while filtration traps those particles, removing them from circulation. Improving air quality in schools will help keep students, staff, and education healthy from respiratory illnesses in school.

Further, with the increased timeline for and extent of wildfires in Oregon, improving indoor air quality is becoming an essential requirement for schools. Improving filtration systems will make our schools a haven for students during fire season, rather than a health risk.
