Questions & Answers For HB 2905

Question: If the standards include Middle Eastern cultures, does it cover Jewish culture as well?

Response:

HB 2095 would add Jewish descent to ORS 329.045, and will therefore require the inclusion of the histories, contributions, perspectives of this identity group as with the other identity groups named in ORS. This bill clarifies the framework to both leave Middle Eastern descent in the definition and include a more specific group—individuals of Jewish descent—making it more inclusive and expansive.

The passage of this bill would not undo any work, and the standards inclusive of ethnic studies are still on track for school year 26-27.
