**RE: Support HB 2717 Outdoor Preschool Licensing Pilot Bill** 

Chair Reynolds & members of the Committee,

My name is Dana Hepper, and I am the Director of Policy & Advocacy at the Children's Institute. Children's Institute is a statewide advocacy organization. Our vision is for every Oregon child to have the love, care, and education they need.

I am writing in support of House Bill 2717 to establish a pathway to licensure for outdoor preschools. This legislation is one piece of addressing Oregon's child care crisis and supporting the healthy development of young children. We support HB 2717 because:

- Creating a pathway to licensure for these programs will also open the door for outdoor preschools to apply for Preschool Promise and accept child care subsidy increasing access to these programs for children whose families are income-eligible.
- Oregon is building a "mixed delivery" early childhood system so that families can find the
  program that best meets the needs of their child. For some children, outdoor preschool will be
  the best fit.
- Outdoor preschools offer an alternative that can help expand high-quality early childhood
  education options. Hundreds of child care programs closed during the pandemic leaving a
  shortage of child care across Oregon, and outdoor preschool can help reduce child care deserts.

We urge your support of HB 2717 to create a pathway to licensure for outdoor preschools.
