Re: Support for SB 432.1

The Democratic Party of Multnomah County urges passage of Senate Bill 432.1 Behavioral Health Consumer Engagement Act of 2023.

It is in keeping with our 2022 Platform:

## **Article IV. Social Security and Health**

<u>Plank 7</u>: We support publicly funded Mental Health Crisis Services and call on our elected officials to reestablish a comprehensive mental health and behavioral care system.

## **Article VIII. Justice**

<u>Legislative Action Item 5</u>: We call on the state, counties and cities to significantly increase appropriations to programs that divert people from incarceration, such as addiction and mental health treatment, domestic violence services, alternative to incarceration programs, and re-entry services.
