While much more information is needed to truly understand the power within all medicines, I believe there are many ways to collect and use information in ways that reduce potential harms. Many people want to participate in research that will further data and benefit how we understand medicine, healing and recovery. Choice and consent are important along this journey as so many of us have had our choices taken away for a multitude of reasons. Choosing what to share and who to share it with is a step toward empowerment that is needed for healthy community members. Please do not pass bill 303 as it currently reads as this would greatly disrupt the healing potential of these medicines and their modalities.
