The effects of this legacy of discrimination outlined in Elaine Rector's timeline continue to impact the lives of Black people in Oregon in so many ways - - this is heartbreaking, upsetting and unjust.

We SAY that we hold up the values of diversity and equity but if we do not acknowledge our history and current state of racism and take this opportunity to establish a task force reparations in Oregon then our actions tell a different story.

To heal from this legacy means to take responsibility for our actions and our participation NOW in these systems of oppression and support SB776

True change is not going to come from talking about change, it's going to come from repairing harm - this bill will be the first step in moving forward and taking action to repair harm. In order to move forward together in a just society, we must do this.

I urge you to support this bill to establish a task force on reparations because it is the right and just thing to do.
