It is well documented how many challenges face communities of color as we work to support healthy child development and early learning that is culturally appropriate, affirming and sustaining. As a member of the Early Childhood Equity Collaborative, we have struggled to secure funding that will assist us in preparing our children for school and creating education and training to parents and teachers in culturally responsive methods that support learning and retention.

It is an ethical imperative if we are to ensure equitable health and education outcomes for all Oregon children that the ELD has sufficient funding to better support culturally specific early learning programs and services.
