Dear Co-Chair Woods, Co-Chair Gomberg and Members of the Committee:

On behalf of *Foundation for Affordable Housing*, *Inc.* based in Bend, I urge your strong support for SB 5511, the Governor's recommended \$3.76 billion budget for Oregon Housing and Community Services.

Oregon is facing an unprecedented crisis of unsheltered children, adults, and families, as well as extraordinary numbers of households experiencing housing insecurity, living in substandard housing, and living in housing that is increasingly unaffordable relative to incomes. We as Oregonians cannot accept these conditions and let so many of our friends, neighbors, and family members go without their basic housing needs met.

Governor Kotek's budget takes significant and meaningful steps toward tackling this current crisis with *substantial* investments across the housing continuum, including resources that address:
