As cattle ranchers in Southern Oregon we already face a lack of competitive buyers for our calves, thereby lower the prices we receive. If the buyers who purchase our calves and then move them to CAFO's to raise them to market weight are unable to do so, we may be unable to continue ranching.

Our ranch on Elk River has been our family since 1914. As the third and fourth generations working this property, we struggle to keep the ranch profitable as it is.

Please do not pass this unnecessary and very dangerous bill.
