- Re: <u>SB 858</u> Children's Service Districts Support

This bill will allow citizens to sign initiative petitions in their area to support property tax funding of children's services; e.g., afterschool and summer programs. The League has been working on child care issues for many years, including its 1988 position and its 2023 updated child care report.

These are the issues related to the bill as we see them now. Participation in out-of-school-time programs (early learning, after school, and summer) are known to increase academic and lifelong success. These programs are underfunded, particularly for after school and summer and usually children can only participate if their families pay associated fees. Passage of local property tax initiatives would subsidize funding for low-income families. In Oregon, the only people who can put property tax initiatives on the ballot are City Councils or County Commissioners. Citizens cannot file for these initiatives. This measure would allow citizens to initiate ballot initiatives to benefit children's services that could be signed by voters. It does not allocate funds. Initiatives would need to be passed to generate funds that would be allocated by an elected special district board.

Based on our position cited here, we recommend passage of this bill.

We urge your Support of SB 858.
