# Federal Race/Ethnicity Reporting

## Current Data Collection \& Federal Reporting

ODE collects race/ethnicity information for the following racial/ethnic categories: American Indian/ Alaska Native, Asian, Black, Hispanic/Latina/o/x, Native Hawaiian/Pacific Islander, White, Multiracial
Those data are then reported based on the $\mathbf{7}$ approved federal categories after applying the following business rules:

- Hispanic/Latina/o/x regardless of other racial flags
- Multiracial if not Hispanic/Latina/o/x and has more than 1 racial flag
- Each race separately as long as not Hispanic/Latina/o/x or not multiracial

It is possible to extend state reporting of race/ethnicity in a more descriptive way within these constraints

## Conversation on Race/Ethnicity

- ODE's Office of Indian Education is leading data justice conversations on having state reporting that includes specific tribal affiliation within the federal "American Indian/ Alaska Native" category; it is possible that this becomes a model program for review of all other race/ethnicity categories
- The federal Office of Budget and Management convened a work group that developed recommendations about how to improve federal reporting related to race/ethnicity. Highlights include:
- Removal of Hispanic/Latino/a/x reporting exclusion of other racial categories
- Addition of a Middle Eastern/North African category
- Addition of countries of origin within race/ethnicity categories
- Public comment regarding the work group's recommendations is available at this public comment webpage.
- Public comments are due by April 12, 2023.
