I am a Respiratory Therapist and a grandfather to a 5 years old, who lives in Portland. His lungs, like all children's, will continue to develop to be fully mature around the age of 20. But that is only a textbook fact. In reality, his lungs, our adult lungs are affected every minute by the fossil fuel air we breathe. I SUPPORT SB 803 which would gradually phase out fossil fuel diesel in Oregon. This is the time to take BOLD action with your POLITICAL COURAGE to move away from petroleum or fossil fuels, the source of black smoke, and black carbon. Black Carbon is a greenhouse gas, a warming agent 450 times more potent than C02. 60% of all black carbon comes from petroleum diesel and is one of Oregon's biggest man-made contributors to premature snow melt and climate warming. Renewable diesel(not biodiesel) is made from plant-based oils, used cooking oils, animal fats, and wood waste. It emits up to 80% less greenhouse gas reducing 5.1 million metric tons of C02 annually.

You will hear misinformation from lobbyists supporting the oil industry and Timber Unity although their grandchildren breathe the same polluted air as my grandson. I conclude with the following paragraph from the American Lung Association. Thank you for your time. Hjalmer
