We are writing to you to encourage you to vote against SB4 for the following reasons:

1. SECTIONS 10 & 11 subvert the current land use process by granting to the governor unilateral power to override local and state planning processes. This is a dangerous power grab that must be stopped

2. SITING SEMICONDUCTOR FACILITIES ON AGRICULTURAL LAND POSES AN IMMEDIATE THREAT TO FOOD SECURITY FOR OREGON. The class I & II soils in this area are among the best agricultural soils in the world. If the pandemic taught us anything, it should be that supply chains can not be trusted in times of emergency, and we must be able to provide for ourselves.
