With the OSSRP LMI and Solar Within Reach ETO program, their \$22,791.00 solar bid went down to \$11,791.00, making it an affordable option. The solar addition will ensure 9000 kWh/yr of local solar power production will insulate them from the rising cost of power as they retire at the energy efficient home they are building now. The \$5000 OSSRP made this possible for them.





Abigail Bok recently retired to Coos Bay from California. Knowing she would be on a fixed income, she explored adding solar to her new home utilizing savings she had accrued.

A solar electric system would help insulate her from the rising cost of energy in Pacific Power territory. The availability of the OSSRP and Solar Within Reach made this project possible for Abigail. She'll produce 14,000 kWh/yr, helping offset the majority of her power consumption on an annual basis.
