I urge you to support House Bill 3213 which will prohibit the sale in Oregon of cosmetics tested on animals.

- Rabbits, mice, rats, and guinea pigs are typically used to test cosmetics like lipstick, deodorant, and shampoo.
- Cosmetic products sold in the United States are not legally required to be tested on animals to show safety for use on humans.
- If a company wants to use a new ingredient in their products, they can use alternative test methods that are often less expensive and more relevant to humans than animal tests.
- 10 states, including California, and 30 countries, have already banned the sale of cosmetics newly tested on animals.
