SB 907 does not create a new right– nor does it give an unfettered right for workers to refuse to work. It takes an existing right that is hidden in an administrative rule, and clarifies it in statute. It would use Oregon's already-established rebuttable presumption to protect workers who exercise this right from retaliation.
