House Committee Climate, Energy, Environment Re: HB3152 – Support

Chair Marsh, Vice-Chairs Levy and Levy, and committee members, my name is Karen Harrington testifying in support of HB3152 on behalf of Climate Reality Project, Portland Chapter.

The international scientific community continues to produce reports telling us that we must do everything we can to invest in a clean energy future, not fossil fuels. As Oregon continues to move toward that clean energy future, it makes no sense to allow utilities to put the cost burden of continued investments in methane (natural gas) infrastructure onto customers. We need to protect customers from stranded assets, which is exactly what HB3152, the Utility Consumer Protection Bill, with -2 amendment does. We note that SB 868, the Healthy Heating and Cooling For All Bill, which will assist customers to access and install cleaner, more efficient solutions– is an important complement to HB3152.

HB3152 protects customers from financial risk as utilities continue to invest in natural gas expansion even as their share of energy consumption is, and needs to, decline. Clean electricity and efficient electrical equipment like heat pumps– which provide both heating and air conditioning in one system, and induction stoves– are the clear choice for air quality and lowering energy burdens.

We must ensure that utility regulation is in line with climate regulation. We ask for your support of the Utility Consumer Protection Bill (HB 3152), which will protect

customers from funding these fossil fuel systems which continue to emit greenhouse gasses escalating climate change. New fossil fuel investments today can last 60 years. This bill will direct regulators to align with state climate regulations and move us to a future that addresses climate and reduces emissions.

We respectfully request your support of HB3152.
