AND YOU WANT TO MAKE IT A CLASS B MISDEMEANOR OFFENSE FOR LOVING ANIMAL OWNERS TO USE ANIMALS FOR:

- (a) "Education program" means an animal exhibition designed to impart information about an animal's natural behavior, habitat or life cycle for educational or conservation purposes.
- (b) "Performance" means a carnival, circus, display, exhibition, exposition, fair, parade, petting zoo, photographic opportunity, race, ride, trade show or similar undertaking during which an animal performs tricks, gives rides or otherwise entertains or amuses an audience, whether or not a fee is charged.
- (c) "Traveling animal act" means a performance of an animal to which the animal is transported to perform.

Once again, if you do not see the danger in this bill then you are the problem, not the solution. If you consider this bill, you are breaking the law as it is clear in the Fifth and Fourteenth Amendment. Stop this bill now AND ANY OTHER BILLS OF SIMILAR NATURE THAT YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR.
