Concealed handgun license holders represent the most responsible gun owners. Laws that specifically target them do nothing to address the issue of gun violence, public safety or criminal activity. All this does is put CHL holders at risk of having their firearms stolen by requiring them be left in cars when visiting "sensitive" areas and make it far too easy to become a criminal by accident with no malicious intent.
