My name is Whitney Eikmeier and I'm a volunteer with the American Cancer Society Cancer Action Network. We urge your support of HB 3090 to end the sale of menthol cigarettes and all other flavored tobacco products in Oregon. All products, all flavors, all locations, no exceptions.

Prevention is the greatest tool we have in public health. Tobacco-related illness remains the number one cause of preventable death in Oregon. Over 8,000 Oregonians will die of smoking-related illness this year. According to the CDC and the Oregon Health Authority, 95% of adults who smoke first started before the age of 21, but fewer than 25% of these same adults use any form of flavored product, while 85% of youth who smoke started use a flavored product, and 80% exclusively use a flavored product.
