I strongly support House Bill 2002. In a time when we are seeing and experiencing a calamitous reversal of rights across the country, in Oregon we will be on the right side of history by protecting the rights of reproductive health and of gender affirming healthcare. While Oregon's Constitution already protects abortion rights and reproductive healthcare, this House Bill wisely recognizes the need to strongly enact broad protections, as opponents strive to undermine these indispensable human rights. This House Bill also accomplishes needed protections for the healthcare providers whose expertise offers access to reproductive healthcare. House Bill 2002 also enacts necessary protection against attempts to undermine the rights of Oregon's trans population to gender-affirming healthcare.
